WHAT IS RxREPORTS?

RxReports provide a series of pre-defined detail and summary reports that can be used to assist in managing prescription drug benefits. Prescribing patterns and ranking measurements can help identify drug usage trends by therapeutic class and/or by individual drug. Reports are available in four pathways—pharmacy, drug, member, and doctor.

Unless indicated, information used by RxReports is based on filled claims data that is supplied by the customer.

WHICH FEATURES ARE AVAILABLE IN RxREPORTS?

Specifically, RxReports features include:

- An AutoSave option. AutoSave saves reports in progress to be viewed at a later time.
- Sorting capabilities. Reports can be sorted by one or more columns in descending or ascending order.
- Searching capabilities. Using filters, reports can be searched for specific data or for a range of data.
- Drill-down capabilities. The drill-down feature lists reports that contain details about selected data from a summary report.
- Graphing options. Report data can be represented in graph format. Up to two categories of report data can be charted on one graph. Eighteen graph designs are available.
- Export options. Data from a report or from a graph can be saved in file format and then exported to a spreadsheet or copied into a word processing document.
- Printing options. Report data can be formatted for the printed page. The report can be enlarged or reduced, and page margins can be adjusted.

WHAT ARE THE MOST COMMON REPORTS AVAILABLE, WHAT'S IN THEM, AND WHICH DRILL DOWNS ARE AVAILABLE?

Report	Feature	Drill Down Options
High Utilization	Provides a list of members with either the highest overall prescription utilization based on minimum number of prescriptions or a total claim amount.	None Available
Member Ranking	Ranks members by either the number of prescriptions, ingredient cost, or total net cost and is based on detailed data within a specified date range.	None Available
Member Ranking by Drug	Identifies members with prescriptions written for a specific drug and strength. Ranks members by either the highest number of prescriptions, ingredient cost, or total net cost. Available by Generic Product Identifier (GPI) or Drug Identification Number (DIN) code.	None Available
Therapy Class Ranking	Ranks therapy classes by either the number of prescriptions filled, ingredient cost, or net cost.	Drug Ranking by Therapy Class (GPI & DIN)
Utilization Summary	Provides a review of changes in cost and utilization for key statistics over a defined time period.	None Available
Utilization Summary by Group	Displays the experience of the group within a plan for a given time period.	None Available
